FEAST OF ST FRANCIS

ENTRANCE ANTP. Francis, the man of God, left his home behind, abandoned his inheritance and became poor and penniless, but the Lord raised him up.

1st READING: Sirach 50, 1. 304, 6-7 *Just as Israel's high priest, Simon II, did much to promote both the public worship in the Temple and the welfare of his people, so Francis of Assisi and his followers through conformity to Christ renewed the life of the Church and inspired reform of the social order.*

PSALM: Responsorial Psalm
You, Lord, are my allotted portion

2nd READING: Galatians 6, 14-18 *The cross is a stark reminder of the conflict between good and evil, of the victory over evil by the saving death of Christ on the cross. It is now the sign of salvation, the tree of life, that makes us a new creation, signed with the brand marks of Christ.*

GOSPEL ACC. Alleluia, Alleluia! Francis poor and lowly enters heaven rich in virtue, greeted with celestial hymns. Alleluia!

GOSPEL Matthew 11, 25-30 *Christ reveals the mysteries of God to the lowly but withholds them from the proud. He also lightens the burdens of the humble and gives them peace of heart.*

COMM ANTP. Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the Kingdom Heaven.
