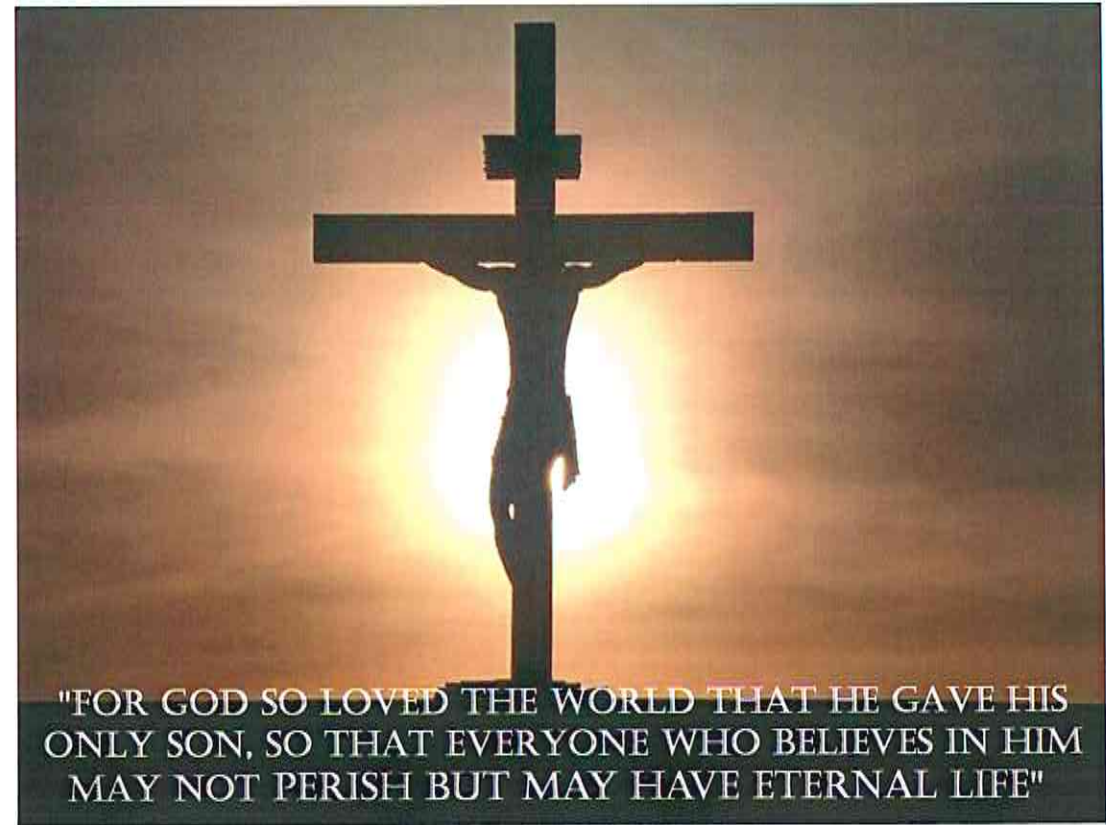

It is essential for our Christian belief to know that God's love for every created being was the motivation to send the Son to redeem the world. It was not out of condemnation of the world, but to deliver it from all that is immoral and destructive. John used the theme of light and darkness throughout his gospel to show the radical difference between salvation in Christ and the workings of evil. The light of the Spirit penetrates the human heart and exposes all the darkness within. Each individual is offered a choice to respond or turn away from the grace of God. Rejecting God's love, brings condemnation upon oneself, whereas acceptance brings salvation. Each person is responsible for his or her own choices.



HOLY WEEK begins with Palm Sunday and ends with the summit of the Liturgical Year — the **EASTER TRIDUUM** - from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. During Holy Week, we celebrate the Passion of Christ, who died on Good Friday in reparation for the sins of mankind, and rose on Easter Sunday to give new life to all who believe. Thus, while Holy Week is solemn and sorrowful, it also anticipates the joy of Easter through the recognition of God's goodness in sending His Son to die for our salvation.
