"He took bread, said the blessing, broke it, and gave it to them, and said "Take it; this is my body" (v 22).

Jesus celebrated the Passover meal with his disciples in Jerusalem. Passover was one of Israel's three principal feasts, along with Pentecost and Tabernacles Passover commemorated Israel's departure from slavery in Egypt into the Promised Land.

During the Passover meal, the host explained the sacred rituals. Jesus transformed these rites into the Christian Eucharist. The bread, blessed, broken and shared, became his body given up for the redemption of the world.

The cup blessed and drunk was his blood shed for the forgiveness of sin. Jesus would seal the new covenant with his own body and blood on Calvary. After singing songs of praise, the disciples followed Jesus to his passion and death.



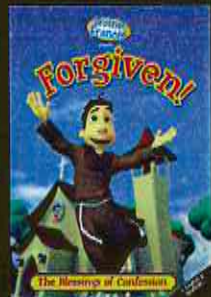

### St. Anthony of Padua, Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> June

Born in Lisbon, Portugal, in 1195 and baptised Fernando, today's saint became an Augustinian priest. Inspired by a group of Franciscans recently martyred in Morocco, he became a Franciscan himself and took the name Anthony. He preached throughout France & Northern Italy, especially against the Cathari heresy (a form of dualism which believed in a God and an evil one, and rejected marriage). He died at Padua in Italy at age thirty-six.

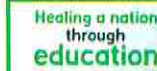
