"This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world" (v.14).

The miracle of the multiplication of bread is narrated by all four evangelists (Matthew 14:13-21 and 15:32-38; Mark 6:31-44 and 8:1-10; Luke 9:10-17), which indicates its Eucharistic importance for the early Church. In John's gospel, the miracle took place near Passover, the Jewish unleavened bread feast (Ex 12:8). When the Israelites were wandering in the wilderness and dying of hunger, God fed them with manna (Ex 16:4). Jesus declared that he himself was the bread that came "down from heaven" to give "life to the world" (Jn 6:33). Like the prophet Elisha (2 Kgs 4:42-44), Jesus took the loaves of barley bread, the humble food of the poor, gave thanks (Greek, *eucharisteō*), broke and distributed it to the hungry people.

The people's reaction: "This is truly the Prophet, the one who is to come into the world," refers to the "prophet like Moses" (Deut 18:15, 18) who was anticipated in the final days. However, the people looked for a Messiah who would be king and a conqueror who would drive the Romans from the land. When Jesus realized this, he withdrew to the mountain alone.
