"Those who eat my flesh and drink my blood have eternal life, and I will raise them up on the last day" (v.54).

Jesus is both word and sacrament. In the sixth chapter of John's Gospel, there are two important elements in Jesus' pronouncement that he was the "bread of life" (v.35). In John 6:35-50, the "bread of life" is a figure of God's revelation in Jesus—the "word made flesh" (1:14). Beginning in verse 51, the sacramental theme comes to the fore. Just as God fed the Israelites with heavenly manna on their wilderness journey in the Exodus (Ex 16:4), Jesus nourished the faithful with his own body and blood on their spiritual journey. Jesus plainly said that his flesh was "true food" and his blood was "true drink" (v.55). The reality of these words was emphasized by the Greek word for eating (*trogos*) that meant to "gnaw" or to "munch." Ordinary bread sustained human life, but "heavenly bread" enabled those who ate it to receive divine life. In the Eucharist we are spiritually transformed by Christ's body and blood so that we can worthily enter God's eternal reign.

TO LOVE: In what ways am I Christ's presence to those I meet today?
TO SERVE: Lord Jesus, help me to appreciate your presence in the Eucharist.
