The deaf and dumb man in today's Gospel stands for all of us whose ears and shut to listen to the word of God and cannot prise the Lord by our mouth. Before the coming of Christ, all had their ears closed to the message from heaven, and the chosen people refused to listen even to the prophets who communicated God's message. They had become deaf and dumb. By curing the deaf and dumb, Jesus teaches us that a new dialogue between heaven and earth has begun and our hearts should be open to the Gospel, our ears be attuned to the Word of God and our lips should sing His praises.


