Understanding Mass Offerings and Memorial Donations

Did you know there are two ways to remember your deceased loved ones throughout the year? Many people like to have a Mass offered to remember a deceased loved one on that person's birthday, anniversary of death or other special day. The offering for such a Mass is a minimum of \$10 per person remembered. The offering for a Month's Mind Mass which is celebrated about one month after a person's death, in memory of the deceased, is a minimum of \$50 per Mass. [Current at July 2013]. You simply need to contact the Parish Office via telephone (08) 83373849 to schedule the Mass.

A more significant way to remember a deceased loved one is through a memorial donation. Like Mass offerings, memorial donations can be made for any special occasion. They are also a great idea at the time of death. You simply need to state in the obituary, "Memorial donations to St Francis of Assisi Catholic Church appreciated." The benefits of a memorial donation or gift include:

- The donation or gift may be as large or as small as a donor wants it to be.
- While Mass offerings can only be used to cover the actual cost of the Mass, memorial donations and gifts can be used for any of the many operating needs of the church including assistance for maintenance and upgrading of our facilities or support and development of our many ministries and outreach projects.
- For large memorial donations or gifts the parish can work with the donor(s) to determine a way to use the donation or gift that would be most appropriate to the interests and preferences of the individual who is being memorialized through the gift.

If you would like to offer friends and family the opportunity to make memorial donations or gifts to our church when they visit the Funeral Home for a deceased loved one, simply contact our Parish Office for a supply of this flyer and Memorial Donation Envelopes.


Donors are sent a letter, and an acknowledgement is sent to the family of the deceased or the person you wish to honour.

St Francis of Assisi Catholic Parish Policy Regarding Memorial Donations

- I. For monetary donations in memory, or in honour, of an individual the Parish will provide special envelopes or a simple form to designate such donations. Marketable securities or any similar property easily turned into cash, without restriction as to use, need no approval or other process.
- 2. Gifts of tangible properties offered to the church will be considered on a case-by-case basis in order to ascertain if they further the ministry of the church, are consistent with our mission and testimony, and reflect our Christian values. The Parish Finance Council will serve as the body of the parish designated to consider such gifts.
